

Frick, Wilhelm

(1877--1946), German Minister of the Interior from January 1933 to August 1943 and governor of the Protectorate of Bohemia and Moravia from 1943 until the end of the war. As Interior Minister, Frick issued most of Germany's racial laws. He was one of the major war criminals hanged on October 16, 1946. (see also Bohemia and Moravia, Protectorate of.)
